Midterm Review Guide

Complete the midterm review below. This guide is meant to accomplish two things: 1) To help prepare you for the Midterm Exam, and 2) To give you an indication of how successful you will be on the exam. Each section asks you to do different tasks, ranging from basic definitions to more evaluating, and comparing and contrasting different ideas. You should complete this review guide without the help of notes, textbooks, or your classmates.

- If you can complete Part 1 you are a **Congressional Aide**. You have a decent grasp of the basic information of the unit. If all you can do is complete this section you are likely to get a D or F on the test.
- If you can complete Parts 1 and 2 you are a **US Citizen**. You have a good grasp of the basic information of the unit and you can start to go into greater depth about these key ideas and concepts. If you can complete both of these parts, you are likely to get a C or D on the test.
- If you can complete Parts 1, 2 and 3 you are an **Associate Justice**. You have an excellent grasp of the key concepts, and go into great detail, but now you are able to evaluate these ideas. If you can complete these three parts, you are likely to get a B or C on the test.
- If you can complete Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 you are an **Experienced Politico**. You have an excellent grasp of all the key concepts, can analyze and evaluate the information, and most importantly you can start applying these to different situations and scenarios. If you can complete all four parts, you are likely to get a B on the test.
- If you can complete Parts 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 you are an **Elder Statesman**. You have an excellent grasp of all the concepts, can analyze, evaluate and apply these concepts in different ways, making connections between them and most importantly you can start articulating them in new ways. If you can complete all five parts, you are likely to get an A on the test.
